You need to include:

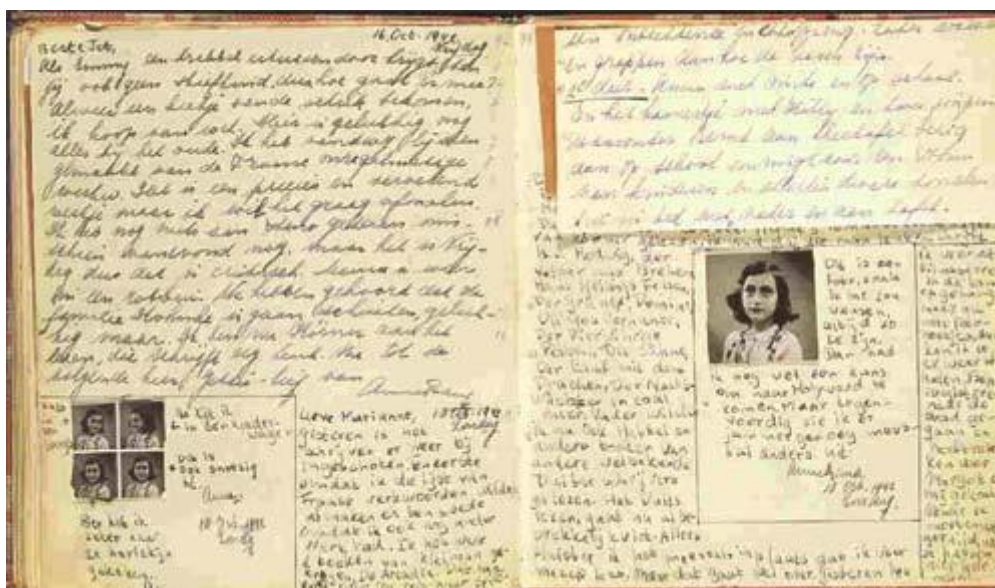
- Where she began her life/ her family background
